HEAD	ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
No caps, visors, hoods, bandanas or other head gear, except with administrative permission.		
UPPER GARMENTS	ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
All garments must cover shoulder to shoulder. No	Shoulder straps must be at least 2 inches wide. Mid-Drifts should not be visible.	
rips/tears or skintight items.		
All garments must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline or stay tucked.		
NO halter tops, tanks tops, spaghetti straps or muscle shirts.		
LOWER GARMENTS	ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered even while seated.		
Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length. No rips/tears or skintight items.		
No rips/tears or skintight items.	Leggings are acceptable if t	he shirt reaches mid-thigh.

Attire should not depict tobacco/alcohol/drugs, nor any offensive, racial, gang-related, sexual, or violent images.
